The Semiahmoo Rotary Club is proud to announce the 9th Annual SASSY Awards. SASSY stands for "Service Above Self" Surrey Youth, incorporating Rotary's motto. The awards aim to recognize, acknowledge and celebrate the achievements of youth who exemplify the ideals of Rotary by making a positive impact in our community and around the world.

Nominations are now being accepted in 7 categories for youth aged 15 to 21 living, studying or working in Surrey or White Rock. The awards will be presented at the Awards Show on Thursday, May 9, 2019 at Surrey City Hall.

Each Award Recipient will receive:

All nomination/applications must be received by Semiahmoo Rotary Club (White Rock) no later than Wednesday February 27, 2019 (11:59PM)

Awards Categories and Selection Criteria

Community Service (local)

This category recognizes youth who have made an outstanding positive contribution to the local community.

Criteria considered includes:

- Starting or significantly supporting a local charity, organization, or initiative
- Contributing to make the charity, organization or initiative sustainable and ongoing
- Volunteering and making a considerable difference in the local community
- Being a role model for youth and encouraging their involvement in community service

Environmental Leadership

This category recognizes youth who have made an outstanding positive contribution to the local community.

Criteria considered includes:

- Committed involvement on environmental issues in the community
- Creating or significantly supporting the effective implementation of an environmental initiative
- Empowering and increasing the capacity and leadership skills of peers to be involved in environmental activities

International Service (global)

This category recognizes youth who have made an outstanding contribution to an international service initiative.

Criteria considered includes:

- Founding or significantly supporting a global/international service initiative
- Contributing to make the initiative sustainable and ongoing
- Building capacity in the host community
- Being a role model for youth and encouraging their involvement in global community service

Overcoming Adversity

This category recognizes youth who have overcome difficult circumstances, reached personal goals, and who have gone on to take on a leadership role.

Criteria considered includes:

- Having overcome challenges and succeeded in accomplishing goals
- Having made a positive impact in the community
- Emerged as a leader in school or community activities

Youth Leadership

This category recognizes youth who have made an outstanding contribution to the local community by motivating and empowering young people.

Criteria considered includes:

- Creating or significantly supporting opportunities for youth to participate in a program, event, initiative, council, or group
- Empowering and increasing the capacity and leadership skills of peers
- Mentoring and being a role model to youth in school or community activities

Sports Leadership

This category recognizes youth who have made an outstanding impact on the local community as an athlete or coach.

Criteria considered includes:

- Leading, supporting and mentoring youth to participate in sport
- Empowering youth to enhance their skills and abilities in sport
- Being a role model for youth in sport
- Contributing to the growth of opportunities for participation in sport for all ages

Arts and Culture Leadership

This category recognizes youth who have made an outstanding impact on the local arts and cultural community (including performing, visual, and literary arts, organizations and events).

Criteria considered includes:

- Creating or significantly supporting opportunities for youth to participate in arts and cultural activities, events and organizations
- Empowering youth to enhance their skills and abilities in the literary, performing or visual arts
- Being a role model for youth involved in the arts and cultural activities
- Contributing to the growth of opportunities for participation in the arts and cultural activities or events for all ages

Eligibility Criteria & Other Information

Eligibility Criteria

In order to be eligible for the SASSY Awards, nominees/applicants must be:

Between the ages of 15 to 21 as of February 27, 2019 A resident, enrolled in a school, or working in Surrey or White Rock. Available for a video interview on April 6th or 7th, 2019 if chosen as a Finalist. Available to attend the Awards Show on Thursday May 9, 2019 in Surrey. Proof of eligibility may be required to validate final nominees.

- School the Nominee/Applicant is currently attending (or attended in the past)
- Nominee/Applicant age and birth date
- Description of notable accomplishments (500 words max)
- Description of personal character qualities (250 words max)
- Other information that supports the consideration of the Nominee/applicant (250 words max)
- Include the nominee's/applicant's choice of registered Canadian Charity, including contact name, phone, email and registration #
- Include two letters of recommendation (should be on letterhead, scanned and uploaded)
